

Location:

On Royalston Nature Reserve. Park at the Boma. If there is a function at the Boma park at the parking area behind the Boma next to the Lakehouse road.

Markers:

Yellow.

Description:

- Leaving the Boma entrance veer slightly left and follow the two-track next to the forest.
- At the bottom of the two-track you will find the entrance to the forest.
- Walk approximately 100m into the forest and you will find a side path to the right that leads to a magical viewpoint (about another 100m).
- There is a picnic table and benches at the top with a spectacular view.
- You can see the houses at Kini Bay and further along Seaview.
- This is a wonderful spot for sundowners or maybe even a picnic breakfast.
- (If you intend having sundowners or a picnic only you can park at the entrance to the forest.)
- Rejoining the main trail turn right and you will find yourself in beautiful forest vegetation.
- Follow the yellow arrows. Do not take the first path to the left or the next to the right.
- The trail leads down and up through the forest until you emerge at a boundary fence.
- Follow the arrows through a bush path down the steep sand hill emerging at the 90° turn on the Lakehouse road at the little dam. (This lovely path was created by the animals who decided the sand dune was too hectic to walk).
- Turn left and after a short walk you will re-enter the forest.
- You then make your way up through the forest, ending back on the original trail.
- Make your way out of the forest and along the two-track back to the Boma.
