

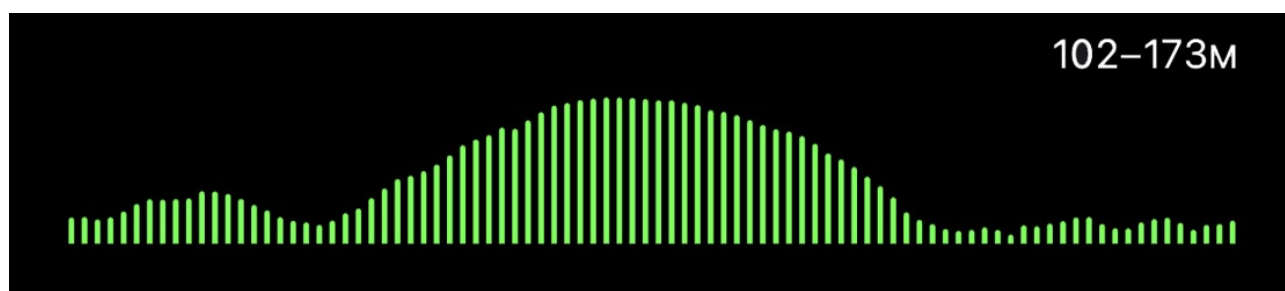
Lake Trail



Distance: 4.5km

Difficulty: 3/5

Location:

On Royalston Nature Reserve. Park your vehicle at the parking area at the Chapel at Lakehouse. The entrance is on the west side of the parking area. Check to see that there isn't a wedding or function being held at the Lakehouse. If this is the case you can park on the old exit road and start there.

Markers:

Description:

- The start of this trail follows the same route as the Wood Owl Trail.
- Starting on the west side of the Chapel car park follow a track that crosses the old tar exit road.
- Cross the tar road and follow the track past a very big Bluegum on your right.
- The trail will narrow after a short way as you enter the thick forest.
- Watch out for the **white** arrow that needs to be followed taking you off the Wood Owl Trail.
- Turn right to follow this arrow and walk up and over a fairly steep hill that is quite sandy at times.
- At the bottom you will join the Lakehouse road.
- Turn left (westwards) and follow the road.
- After a short way turn right up a side road.
- Walk up this beautiful path which has overhead trees forming a canopy.
- At the top veer to the right and follow the two-track (eastwards).
- You will now walk along the ridge with beautiful views over the plains.
- At the end of this two-track veer slightly left and enter the forest (to the left of a very big prickly pear bush).
- Walk down this path until near the bottom where you will turn right and follow the trail.
- You will get right near the Anglers road and veer right again.
- Follow the trail and you will join up with the Anglers road.
- Turn right and follow this Anglers two-track.
- Follow this two-track along the side of the lake.
- You will end up at the Lakehouse parking area.
- Walk up to your starting point, the Chapel parking area.
