

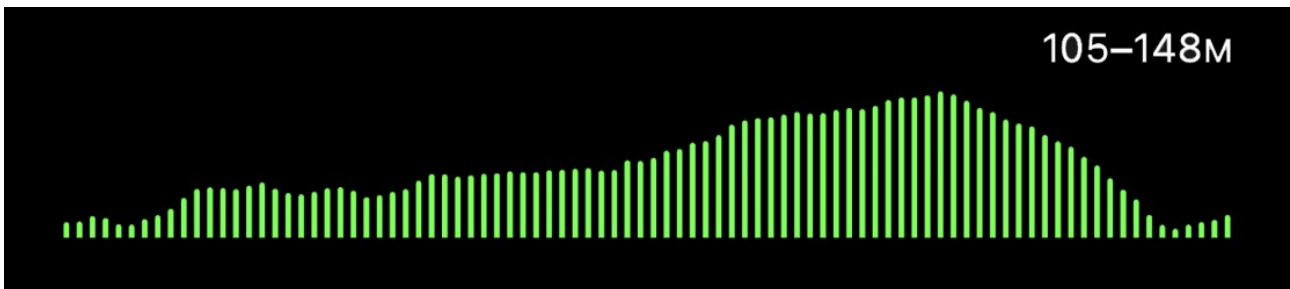
Wood Owl Trail



Distance: 2.5km

Difficulty: 2/5

Location:

On Royalston Nature Reserve. Park your vehicle at the parking area at the Chapel at Lakehouse. The entrance is on the west side of the parking area. Check to see that there isn't a wedding or function being held at the Lakehouse. If this is the case you can park on the old exit road and start there.

Markers:

Green.

Description:

- The start of this trail is the same as the Lake Trail.
- Starting on the western side of the Chapel car park follow a pathway that crosses the old tar exit road.
- Cross this tar road and walk past a very big Bluegum tree on your right.
- The trail will narrow after a short time as you enter some beautiful pristine Albany thicket forest area.
- This is a great area for birds and the animals love this path.
- You will walk for about a kilometer until the path turns to the left and goes up towards the boundary fence.
- At the two-track below the fence turn left (eastwards) and follow this two-track.
- You get beautiful views over the valley where the Lakehouse road runs.
- Further along you turn left off the two-track to enter the forest.
- Look out for the lovely views of the lake.
- At the bottom you will rejoin the trail.
- Turn right and return to the parking area.
